1.0 CALL TO ORDER

Chairperson Alejandre called the meeting to order at 2:00 p.m. via Zoom.

2.0 ROLL CALL AND ESTABLISHMENT OF QUORUM

Quorum was established.

3.0 APPROVAL OF AGENDA

A motion to approve agenda was made by Member Avila and seconded by Member Murphy. The motion carried unanimously.

4.0 COMMUNITY COMMENTS

There were no public comments.

5.0 APPROVAL OF MINUTES

A motion to approve the September 16, 2020 Meeting Minutes was made by Member

Arellano and seconded by Member Murphy. The motion carried.

6.0 DISCUSSION ITEMS

a. 2020-2021 EV SELPA 1st Interim Budgets

Administrator Metheny and Consultant Tennyson reviewed the 1^s Interim EV SELPA Budgets. The Regionalized Services/Program Specialists budget was revised to align with the new California Department of Education (CDE) template which reflects more special education funding than provided when the budget was developed. The Low Incidence Materials and Equipment budget also reflects additional funds provided by CDE with 15% of the total low incidence funds remaining at the SELPA for the purchase, inventory and maintenance of equipment and materials, and 85% allocated to each district based on low incident disabilities pupil counts. The Regional Behavioral Health Counselors budget was revised to reflect a decrease in the number of students served in the school setting and an increase in the number residential referrals. The Regional Program Oversite of Residential Mental Health budget was revised for this same reason. The Occupational Therapy budget was revised to reflect an increase in the number of contract agency staff required due to an increase in the number of referrals from districts.

7.0 ACTION ITEMS:

a. Approve Revised EV SELPA Regional Programs & Program Transfer Policy and Procedures

Administrator Metheny recommended Board approval for the Revised EV SELPA Regional Programs & Program Transfer Policy & Procedures. The policy has been revised to extend the timelines to allow more time during the preparation year and comply with state laws and regulations. Motion to approve the EV SELPA Regional Programs & Program Transfer Policy & Procedures was made by Member Almendarez and seconded by Member Binks. The motion carried unanimously.

b. Approve 2021-2022 Rialto USD Regional Program Transfer Request

Administrator Metheny presented for Board approval the 2021-2022 Rialto USD Regional Program Transfer Request. The transfer of seven students FY 2020-2021 and 23 students during the FY 2021-2022 was reviewed by Administrator Metheny, Rialto USD Lead Agent Bridgette Ealy and Consultant Dr. Dennis Doyle. Motion to approve the 2021-2022 Rialto USD Regional Program Transfer Request was made by Member Arellano and seconded by Member Murphy. The motion carried unanimously.

c. Approve Updated EV SELPA Fiscal Allocation Plan

Administrator Metheny presented for Board approval the EV SELPA Fiscal Allocation Plan revised to align with the EV SELPA Local Plan approved by the EV SELPA Board of Directors in May 2020 and certified by CDE in June 2020. This plan was presented for Board review on September 16, 2020. Motion to approve the revised EV SELPA Fiscal Allocation Plan was made by Member Avila and seconded by Member Murphy. The motion carried unanimously.

d. Approve Low Incidence Equipment for Surplus/Disposal

Administrator Metheny recommended the Board approve identified low incidence equipment for surplus/disposal. A list of items was provided to SELPAs statewide earlier in the year to ascertain any need for the items. Several local SELPAs did acquire the items. The remainder of the items were deemed obsolete or beyond repair. Board approval for disposal of these items is a California education code requirement. Motion to approve the surplus/disposal of low incidence equipment was made by Member Avila and seconded by Member Murphy. The motion carried unanimously.

e. Approve 2020-2021 Interagency Agreements

Administrator Metheny recommended the Board approve the 2020-2021 Interagency Agreements with California Children's Services and the Inland Regional Center. The annual establishment of interagency agreements such as these are a function of a SELPA as established by CDE. A motion to approve the 2020-2021 Interagency Agreements was made by Member Avila and seconded by Member Murphy. The motion carried unanimously.

8.0 OTHER: The next meeting will be February 24, 2021.

9.0 ADJOURNMENT: Motion to adjourn was made by Member Murphy and seconded by Member Binks. The regular meeting was adjourned at 2:33 p.m.

 - Any recommendations for amending IEP documents as a result of COVID-19
